
- 1) Provide Sunshine State One Call locates.
- Provide any maintenance of traffic set up that may be needed per Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) or Lee County Department of Transportation (LCDOT) specs.
- 3) Locate and expose all existing utilities that may be in conflict.
- 4) Provide and use all shoring devices needed to protect the edge of the road and any other existing structures or utilities.
- Schedule all work with either Daniel Labelle, Water Distribution Manager, or Matt Stephens LCU Supervisor, and Robert Lowery, Lee County Utilities (LCU) Inspector.
- 6) Hand deliver all Boil Water Notices to any customers that will be out of water, allowing at least 48 hours of notice.
- Collect and deliver bacteriological samples to the Lee County Laboratory or Department of Health and provide LCU with 2 Consecutive days of passing results.
- 8) Provide all restoration that is needed to restore the site back to its original state as per LCDOT or FDOT specs. This includes Asphalt, Concrete and Landscaping, ECT. LCU inspector and or LCU Management reserve the right to have contractor redo any job that is not up to LCU standard.
- 9) Provide all R.O.W. permits required.
- 10) All work will be completed in compliance with L.C.U. specs.
- 11) Provide a set of asbuilts, at the time of bacti. Sampling.
- 12) Provide documentation of water main flushing, and pressure testing with L.C.U. inspector on site.
- 13) Provide survey for Lee County R.O.W.

- 14) There will be a mandatory preconstruction meeting at a location to be determined.
- 15) Provide L.C.U. with a preconstruction video detailing the existing site conditions.
- 16) Obtain written permission from property owners where any materials are to be stored, equipment set up, or if work is to be done outside of the Lee County R.O.W. or easement.
- 17) Follow appropriate regulations that pertain to dewatering and the discharge of all water from any excavation.
- 18) Tracer wire must be installed with the new water main.
- 19) Bid this project per L.C.U. provided plans.
- 20) Project must be completed within 90 days of receiving the purchase order.
- 21) Install approximately 2000' of 12" HDPE. All 12" HDPE will be supplied by LCU. Contractor to supply all other materials. This job will include, full bore flush, pressure test and chlorinate, tie in's, Fire Hydrants and Water services, Transferring of water services once the new water main is accepted, replace all meter boxes with new, all restoration's, ect. Please see attached plans for job details. LCU will make decision to keep any and all old meter box lids.
