NAME OF ORDINANCE: Ordinance Amending the Boundaries of Esplanade Lake Club Community Development District

### I. DESCRIPTION OF ORDINANCE

#### A. Statement of Purpose

To adopt an ordinance amending Lee County Ordinance 18-21, as previously modified by Lee County Ordinance 20-10, resulting in the modification of external boundaries through expansion of the Esplanade Lake Club Community Development District in accordance with Ch. 190, Florida Statutes.

#### B. Narrative Summary of Ordinance

A petition has been filed by the Board of Supervisors of the Esplanade Lake Club Community Development District, requesting the Board of County Commissioners to amend the ordinance for this District to modify its external boundaries through expansion. The statutes allow a district to petition to contract or expand the boundaries of a community development district. The requested amendment will increase the existing 797.081 acres contained in the District by approximately 46.293 acres, resulting in a new total acreage within the District of approximately 843.374 acres.
