

**LEE COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_\_**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS CERTIFYING THE LEE COUNTY SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL AND ANNUAL SYSTEM ASSESSMENT ROLLS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025, FOR COLLECTION BY THE LEE COUNTY TAX COLLECTOR PURSUANT TO THE UNIFORM METHOD OF COLLECTION FOR NON-AD VALOREM SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS UNDER SECTION 197.3632, FLORIDA STATUTES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025.**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Lee County is the governing body in and for Lee County, Florida, a political subdivision of the State of Florida; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Lee County Ordinances 11-27 and 96-09, as amended, the Board of County Commissioners of Lee County is required to certify the Residential and Commercial Mandatory Solid Waste Disposal and Solid Waste Annual System Assessment Roll and Facilities Special Assessment Roll to the Lee County Tax Collector for collection of the Solid Waste Disposal and Solid Waste Annual System Assessments; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of County Commissioners on this date to adopt and certify the Residential and Commercial Solid Waste Disposal and Solid Waste Annual System Assessment Roll and Facilities Special Assessment Roll to the Lee County Tax Collector for collection of the Annual Assessments for the period from October 1, 2024 through and including September 30, 2025, such Special Assessments to be collected by the Lee County Tax Collector pursuant to the Uniform Method for Collection of Non-Ad Valorem Special Assessments under Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONER OF LEE COUNTY, FLORIDA THAT:**

**SECTION ONE**

The Residential and Commercial Mandatory Solid Waste Disposal and Solid Waste Annual System Assessment Roll and Facilities Special Assessment Roll as developed by the Lee County Property Appraiser pursuant to Lee County Resolution No. 24-08-18 are hereby officially adopted

and certified to the Lee County Tax Collector for the collection of the Annual Special Assessments, pursuant to the Uniform Method of Collection for Non-Ad Valorem Special Assessments under Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes.

## **SECTION TWO**

The effective period for the collection of the Special Assessments pursuant to the certified Residential and Commercial Assessment Rolls, which shall also include all new residential structures added to the Assessment Rolls shall be from October 1, 2024 through and including September 30, 2025. Residential structures for which a Certificate of Occupancy was applied for and received during September of the current calendar year will be charged the FY2024-2025 Residential Solid Waste Disposal and Solid Waste Assessment Fee for their respective Franchise Area, minus a 4% (four percent) discount, through an internal process established between the Department of Community Development, Fiscal Services, and the Solid Waste Department.

## **SECTION THREE**

This certification shall be accomplished by this Resolution and Florida Department of Revenue Form DR-408A (executed original to be provided by the Lee County Property Appraiser and attached hereto as Exhibit "A" prior to distribution of the tax bills), pursuant to Fla. Admin. Code 12D-18.006 (January 2004).

## **SECTION FOUR**

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the Board of County Commissioners.
