Dissolve the Lee County Governmental Leasing Corporation and Convey Assets to Lee County Item Summary: Authorize the dissolution of the Lee County Governmental Leasing Corporation, a Florida Not-for-profit corporation, and convey the remaining assets of the Corporation to the County. Pursuant to the terms of the 1990 Articles of Incorporation, the assets of the Corporation, upon dissolution of the Corporation, are to be conveyed to the County to be used for "governmental purposes." The Corporation was created for the purpose of acquiring certain real property for Lee County governmental purposes. The resulting entity was then utilized to obtain bond funding to develop the properties with County facilities. There is no statutory, legal, or operational reason to continue the Corporation.
